The Department for IT Education Development of MIPT invites student teams from your university to participate in the Moscow International Workshop, which will be held in an online format on November 28 — December 5, 2020.

The Workshop is organized by MIPT with the support of ITMO University.

The main goal of the Moscow International Workshop is to coach student teams for successful participation in competitive programming competitions and ICPC stages (from regional contests to World Finals)!

The official language is English.

The Workshop will be held in accordance with the two divisions scheme:

- Division A is designed to prepare students to participate and win medals in the next ICPC World Finals.
